cent circus cycle

When the letter after c is e, i, or y, the c usually stands for the "s" sound. Then it's called a soft c. Cent, circus, and cycle are all words that begin with a soft c.





gem magic gym

When the letter **g** comes before **e**, **i**, or **y**, the **g** usually stands for the "j" sound. That's called a **soft g**. You can hear the sound of that **soft g** in the words **gem**, **magic**, and **gym**.



badge large hinge

When the letter *g* comes after *d*, *r*, or *n*, it's usually a *soft g*. You can hear it when you say the words *badge*, *large*, and *hinge*. Did you notice that all these words end in a silent *e*?



cook cape cup

When the letter after c in a word is a, o, or u, the c stands for the "k" sound. That's called a hard c. Cook, cape, and cup are words with a hard c.

game gone gulp

The hard **g** is in words like game, gone, and gulp. That's because when the letter after **g** is a, o, or u, the **g** usually stands for the "g" sound.




"I hope you don't hold a grudge against us for complaining," said hard c. "We owe you an apology."
